



Attestation services for Good Conduct / Police Clearance certificates for the UAE

In the UAE it is now a legal requirement (effective from 4th February 2018) for a Good Conduct / Police Clearance certificate to be issued and attested as part of the visa regulations. This means that expats will need to arrange for the certificate to be issued and attested in the country of issue.

Whilst we are unable to apply for the certificate on your behalf, we can arrange for the attestation work from many countries including the UK, USA, Australia, Canada, Ireland, New Zealand, France, Luxembourg, Monaco, Belgium, The Netherlands, Spain and many more.
